#### JOB DESCRIPTION AND RESPONSIBILITIES

## **Description:**

The Executive Administrative Assistant is responsible for managing all day-to-day communication, project coordination, and administrative support for the offices of the Executive Pastors of the church.

**Reports to:** Executive Pastor of Operations & Executive Pastor of Ministries

#### The Job:

- Act as gatekeeper and liaison to maximize the focus on priorities within the Operations
  & Ministries Department of the church, while maintaining strict confidentiality
- Communicate and distribute budgets, policies, procedures and other information
- Reviewing, Filing, & Tracking necessary employee documentation
- Maintain an efficient system of organization which will include electronic and hard-copy filing and record-keeping. Converting hard-copy files to digital format will be required
- Provide high-level administrative support, managing schedules, meetings, and communication.
- Oversee church operations-related tasks, including coordinating with staff, vendors, and volunteers to ensure smooth day-to-day functions.
- Manage calendars and event logistics, ensuring alignment with ministry goals and operational efficiency.
- Prepare reports, presentations, and documents for leadership meetings, ensuring accuracy and professionalism.
- Serve as a liaison between the executive leaders and ministry leaders, ensuring alignment in vision, communication, and execution of initiatives.
- Assist with volunteer coordination and leadership development, supporting recruitment, training, and engagement efforts.
- Help execute strategic ministry initiatives, working alongside staff to ensure projects and programs run effectively.
- Maintain confidentiality and spiritual integrity, upholding the mission and values of the church in all responsibilities.
