**Mark 5:4 NIV**

cry out and cut himself with  
stones.

**Mark 5:5 NIV**

When he saw Jesus from a distance, he ran and fell on his knees in front of him.

**Mark 5:6 NIV**

He shouted at the top of his voice, “What do you want with me, Jesus, Son of the Most High God? In God’s name don’t torture me!”

**Mark 5:7 NIV**



For Jesus had said to him,  
“Come out of this man, you  
impure spirit!”

**Mark 5:8 NIV**

When they came to Jesus, they saw the man who had been possessed by the legion of demons, sitting there, dressed and in his right mind; and they were afraid.

**Mark 5:15 NIV**

Those who had seen it told the people what had happened to the demon-possessed man—and told about the pigs as well.

**Mark 5:16 NIV**



As Jesus was getting into the boat, the man who had been demon-possessed begged to go with him.

**Mark 5:18 NIV**

Jesus did not let him, but said,  
“Go home to your own people  
and tell them how much the  
Lord has done for you, and  
how he has had mercy on you.”

**Mark 5:19 NIV**

So the man went away and  
**began to tell** in the Decapolis  
how much Jesus had done for  
him. And all the people were  
**amazed.**
