But you should keep a clear mind in every situation. Don't be afraid of suffering for the Lord. Work at telling others the Good News, and fully carry out the ministry God has given you.

2 Timothy 4:5 NLT

As for me, my life has already been poured out as an offering to God. The time of my death is near.

I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, and I have remained faithful.

And now the prize awaits me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will give me on the day of his return.

And the prize is not just for me but for all who eagerly look forward to his appearing.

...been whipped times without number, faced death again and again.

Five times I received from the Jews the forty lashes minus one. Three times I was beaten with rods, once I was pelted with stones, three times I was shipwrecked, I spent a night and a day in the open sea,

2 Corinthians 11:24-25 NLT

I have been constantly on the move. I have been in danger from rivers, in danger from bandits, in danger from my fellow Jews, in danger from Gentiles; in danger in the city, in danger in the country, in danger at sea; and in danger from false believers.

2 Corinthians 11:26 NLT

I have labored and toiled and have often gone without sleep; l have known hunger and thirst and have often gone without food; I have been cold and naked

2 Corinthians 11:27 NLT

Then, besides all this, I have the daily burden of my concern for all the churches.

Who is weak without my feeling that weakness? Who is led astray, and I do not burn with anger?

1. Constantly address your attitude.

2 Timothy 1:11-12, 2:9-10

And God chose me to be a preacher, an apostle, and a teacher of this Good News. That is why I am suffering here in prison.

2 Timothy 1:11-12 NLT

But I am not ashamed of it, for I know the one in whom I trust, and I am sure that he is able to guard what I have entrusted to him until the day of his return.

2 Timothy 1:12 NLT

And because I preach this Good News, I am suffering and have been chained like a criminal. But the word of God cannot be chained.

So I am willing to endure anything if it will bring salvation and eternal glory in Christ Jesus to those God has chosen.



2. Beware of getting sucked into foolish arguments and losing influence.

2 Timothy 2:23-26

Again I say, don't get involved in foolish, ignorant arguments that only start fights. A servant of the Lord must not quarrel but must be kind to everyone, be able to teach, and be patient with difficult people. 2 Timothy 2:23-24 NLT

Gently instruct those who oppose the truth. Perhaps God will change those people's hearts, and they will learn the truth.

Then they will come to their senses and escape from the devil's trap. For they have been held captive by him to do whatever he wants.
