It is not up in heaven, so that you have to ask, "Who will ascend into heaven to get it and proclaim it to us so we may obey it?" Nor is it beyond the sea, so that you have to ask, "Who will cross the sea to get it and proclaim it to us so we may obey it?"

Deuteronomy 30:11-13

If you love me, you will obey what I
command.

John 14:15

No, the word is **very near you**; it is in your mouth and in your heart so you may obey it.

Deuteronomy 30:14

See, I set before you today life and prosperity, death and destruction.

Deuteronomy 30:15

For I command you today to love the Lord your God, to walk in his ways, and to keep his commands, decrees and laws; then you will live and increase, and the Lord your God will bless you in the land you are entering to possess.

Deuteronomy 30:16

But if your heart turns away and you are not obedient, and if you are drawn away to bow down to other gods and worship them,

Deuteronomy 30:17

I declare to you **this day** that you will certainly be destroyed. You will not live long in the land you are crossing the Jordan to enter and possess. This day I call heaven and earth as witnesses against you that I have set before you life and death, blessing and curses. **Now choose life**, so that you and your children may live.
