As he went along, he saw a man blind from **birth**. His disciples asked him, “Rabbi, who **sinned**, this man or his parents, that he was born blind?”

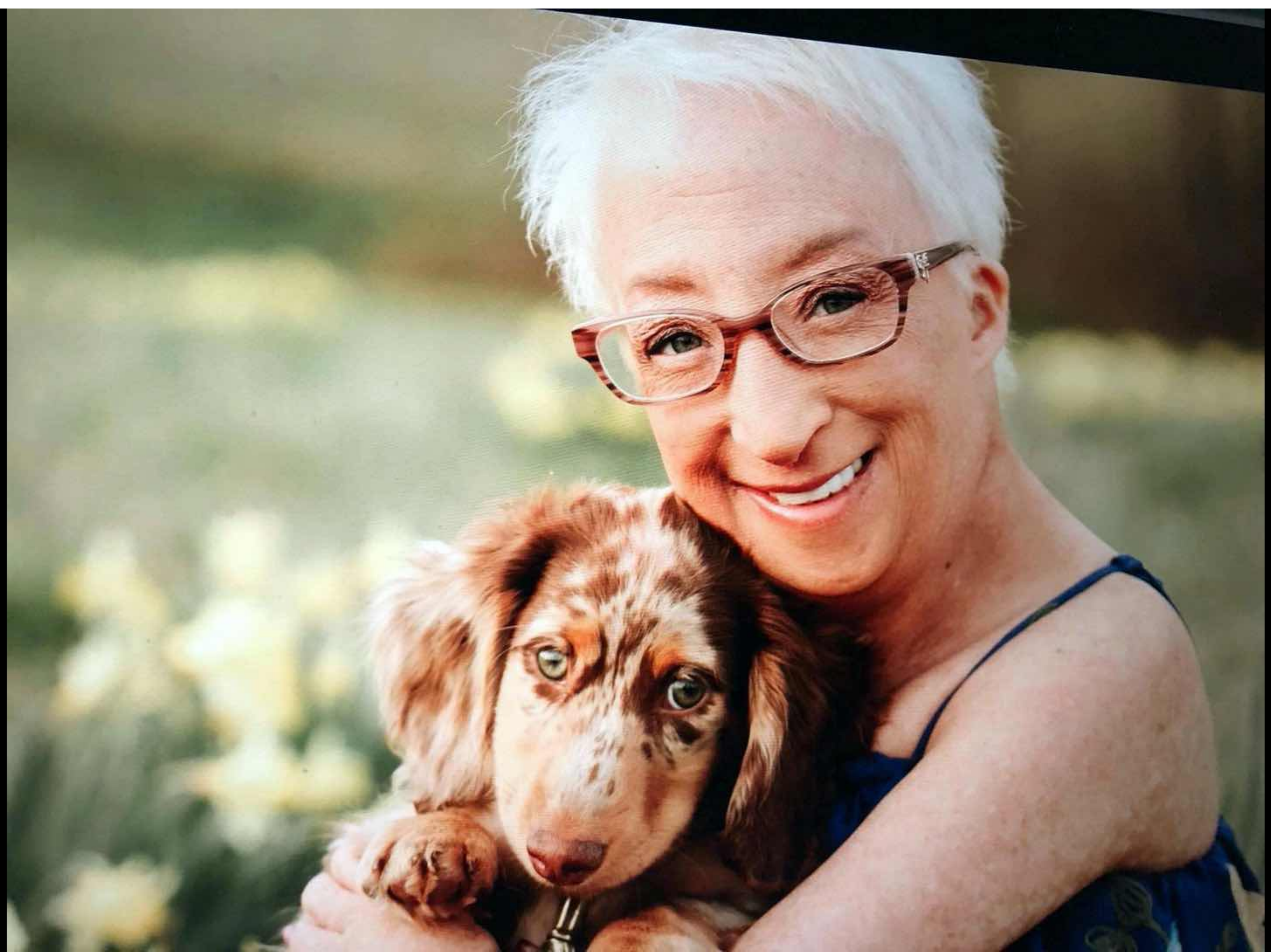
