Purpose of Discipleship Groups

To Connect People in Relationships that Grow Faith. This is a part of becoming a fully devoted follower of Christ that is non-negotiable. You cannot mature in your faith without other believers in your life.

As a part of my discipleship group I commit to:

1. Show up: Consistency is the key to a successful, growing group. Discipleship cannot take place apart from relationships. Relationships are built with time. Discipleship Groups meet 44 weeks of the year (at 1.5 hrs a meeting .008% of the year). Consistency brings with it trust, trust will allow groups to go farther faster and become more of who God intends them to be.

2. Open up:

Groups will be encouraged to open up and talk with one another. When groups begin to talk openly about scripture, the sermon content, and life in general, spiritual maturity will result. When you open up about what you are praying for and who you are inviting will get the whole group on board for support, encouragement, and more potential to celebrate great wins within your group.

3. Build up:

Build up one another's faith: care for one another, encourage one another, challenge one another, pray for one another, etc.
